Basic Husbandry

- You will get a picture or video text of your pets during each visit unless they are, too shy, or hiding. Then, you will get a picture of me in your home for proof of visit.
- Pet feeding, treats, watering, supplements, and/or medication (not applicable for injections). Remember to purchase an extra bag or cans of food in case your pet eats more while you are away, is picky, or to avoid simply running out before your return, especially if trip is extended.
- Play time or exercise, if applicable. Please provide proper equipment and a variety of toys to help burn off energy.
- Petting, snuggling, bonding, and light brushing/combing, if applicable.
- Litter boxes will be cleaned every day to avoid accidents while you are away and check for any abnormalities, so please have extra litter available if your pet tends to use the bathroom more frequently than usual while you are away.
- Small animal housing may be cleaned as well, if applicable. Please make sure materials and cleaning supplies are available. Remember to have an extra heater, light source, or other necessities available, if your specific pet requires them.

Home Upkeep

- Mail Pick Up. Don't forget to give the office notice of permitting me to pick up any packages while you are away or send me codes for the lockers. For trips longer than a week, it may be recommended to leave a mailbox key so yours does not become over-filled.
- Plant Watering.
- Pet mess clean up. Please have supplies available and ready.
- Turn on preferred lights in or outside home to deter break-ins.
- Throw out bad foods and take out trash, if necessary.
- Please let me know if your home requires any other special needs.
